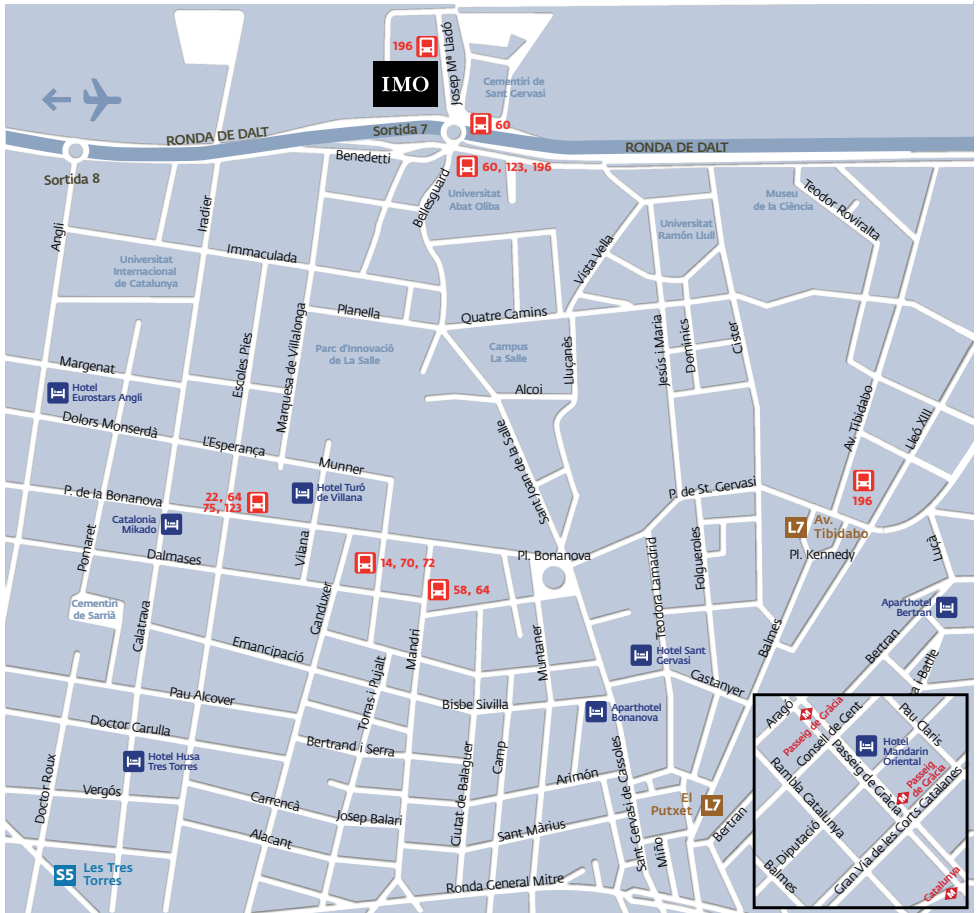

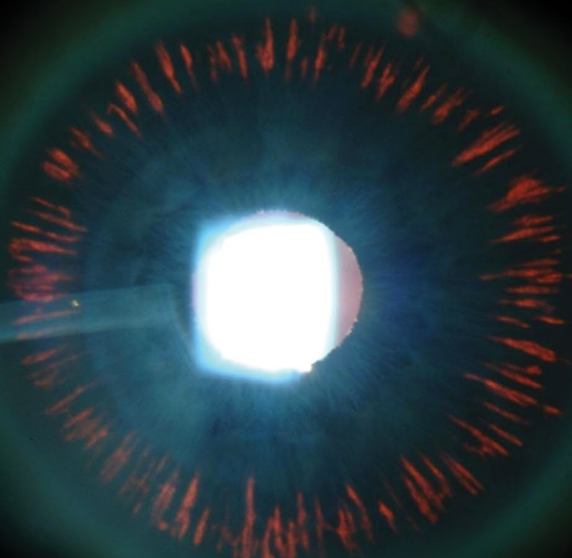


You can reach the IMO by taking Exit 7 on the Ronda de Dalt Ring Road (mountain side), with direct access from calle Josep María Lladó number 3.

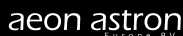
